The origin and Fudo-Myoo

Ooiwasan Nissekiji temple was founded in 725 by Gyōki (famous buddhist priest). In ancient time, this temple flourished as a mountain worship place in Tsurugi Tateyama range. In the golden age, there were 21 affiliated temples, 60 priest's rooms. Ooiwasan Nissekiji temple Magaibutsu (Acala) is one of the important cultural properties in Japan. It consists of 5 statues; Fudō-Myōō, Kongara-Dōji, Seitaka-Dōji, Amida-Nyorai and Gyōki-Bosatsu. Especially, Fudō-Myōō is regarded as one of precious Magaibutsu in Japan. Gyōki curved the powerful figure, and the size, beauty and preservation condition are totally excellent.
